INTERNATIONAL G. MORSIANI AWARD

Total value, net of tax: 5,165.00 Euro

The competition is aimed at promoting scientific research in the grape-growing and wine-making sectors.

Competition regulations

1. Citizens of all European Union Member States can participate by sending four copies of an original work, in Italian, English or French, on research in the grape-growing and wine-making sectors. The work must be sent by registered post and must reach the ASSOCIAZIONE GIUSEPPE MORSIANI, VIALE DEL LAVORO, 8 - 37135 VERONA by November 30st, 2009. (Each work must include a summary in Italian).
2. Groups of researchers, institutes, agencies and corporations are also eligible to take part.
3. Already published works must have appeared in scientific periodicals, or published as monographs not more than two years prior to the year of the competition.
4. The decisions of the Competition Jury shall be final and not subject to appeal. The Jury will inform the Giuseppe Morsiani Association of any work deemed to merit the prize. If the Jury, for whatever reason, does not find any work to be worthy of the award, no award winner will be designated. The Jury's decisions will be announced before March 1st, 2010.
5. The "Giuseppe Morsiani International Grape-growing and Wine-making Award" shall be presented at a ceremony to be held in the course of the 2010 Vinitaly Fair, during the opening events for the Italian Grape and Wine Academy session.
6. The award-winning participant shall be reimbursed for any expenses, supported with receipts, required to attend the award ceremony.
